

## INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTERESTS TO SERVE AS EVALUATOR

- 1. The Central Procurement Board (CPB) is a body set up under section 8 of the Public Procurement Act. One of the core functions of the CPB is to approve the award of major contracts.
- 2. Bids in respect of all major contracts are received, opened and evaluated at the CPB. For the evaluation of bids, the CPB is required, under the law to maintain a list of qualified evaluators to act as members of Bid Evaluation Committees.
- 3. The CPB is in process of updating its existing database of evaluators, and, in that connection, the CPB once again, is inviting **serving as well as retired** professionals having academic/professional qualifications and experience in any field generally related to public procurement to show their interests to form part of future Bid Evaluation Committees.
