INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTERESTS TO SERVE AS EVALUATOR

1. The Central Procurement Board (CPB) is a body set up under section 8 of the Public Procurement Act. One of the core functions of the CPB is to approve the award of major contracts.
2. Bids in respect of all major contracts are received, opened and evaluated at the CPB. For the evaluation of bids, the CPB is required, under the law to maintain a list of qualified evaluators to act as members of Bid Evaluation Committees.

The CPB is in process of updating its existing database of evaluators, and, in that connection, the CPB once again, is inviting **servicing as well as retired** professionals having academic/professional qualifications and experience in any field generally related to public procurement to show their interests to form part of future Bid Evaluation Committees.
